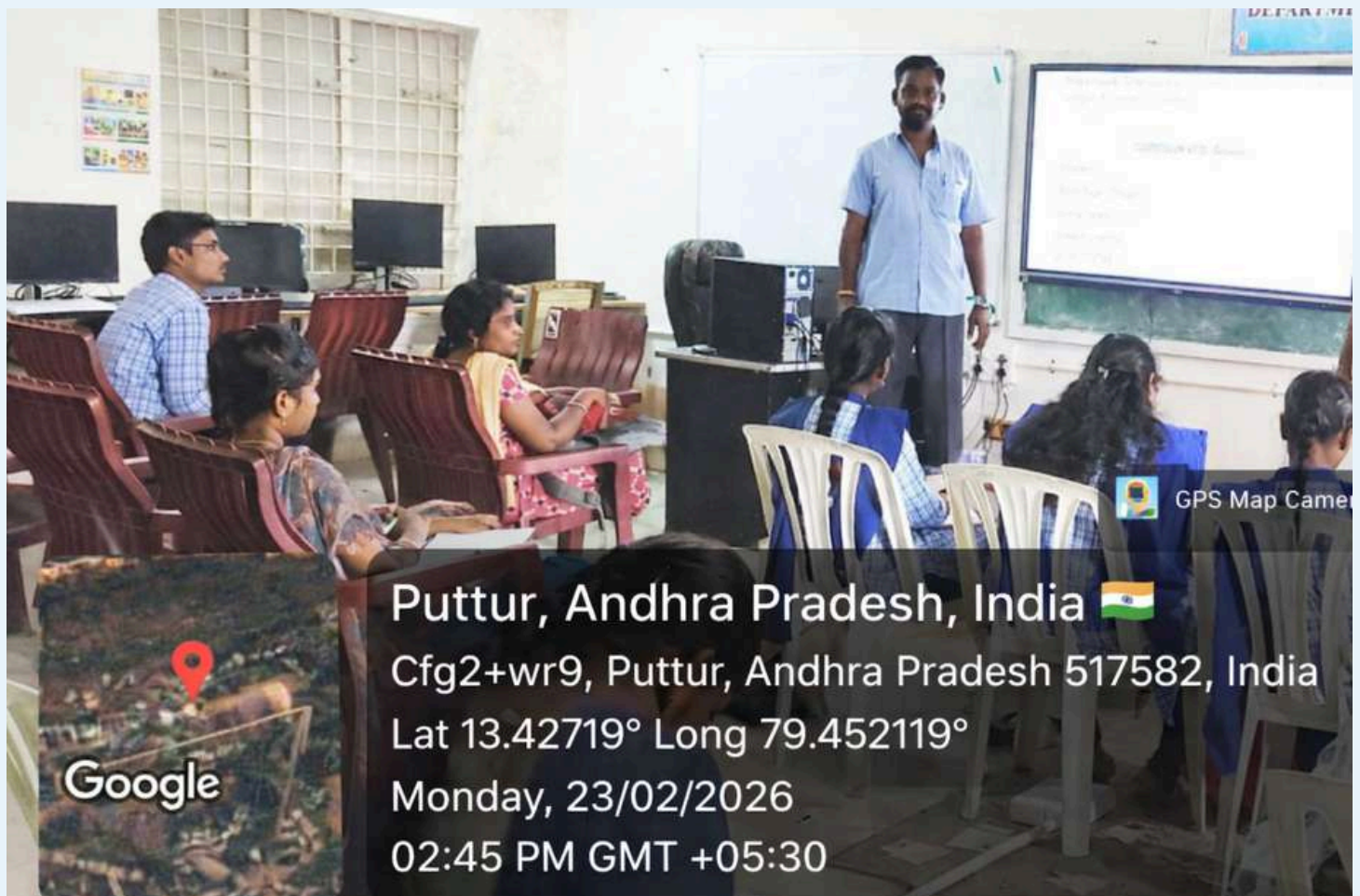
## AWARENESS PROGRAM ON TECHNICAL SKILLS - JKC

The session was highly interactive and informative. Students actively participated and clarified their doubts regarding skill development and competitive exam preparation.

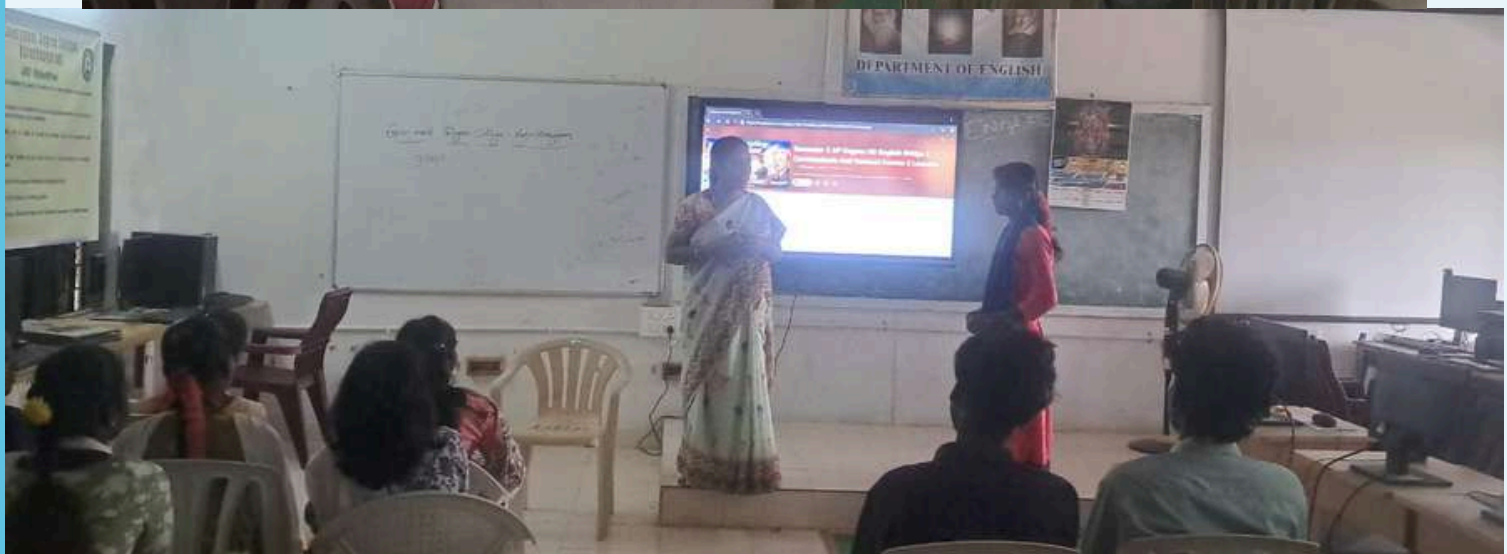
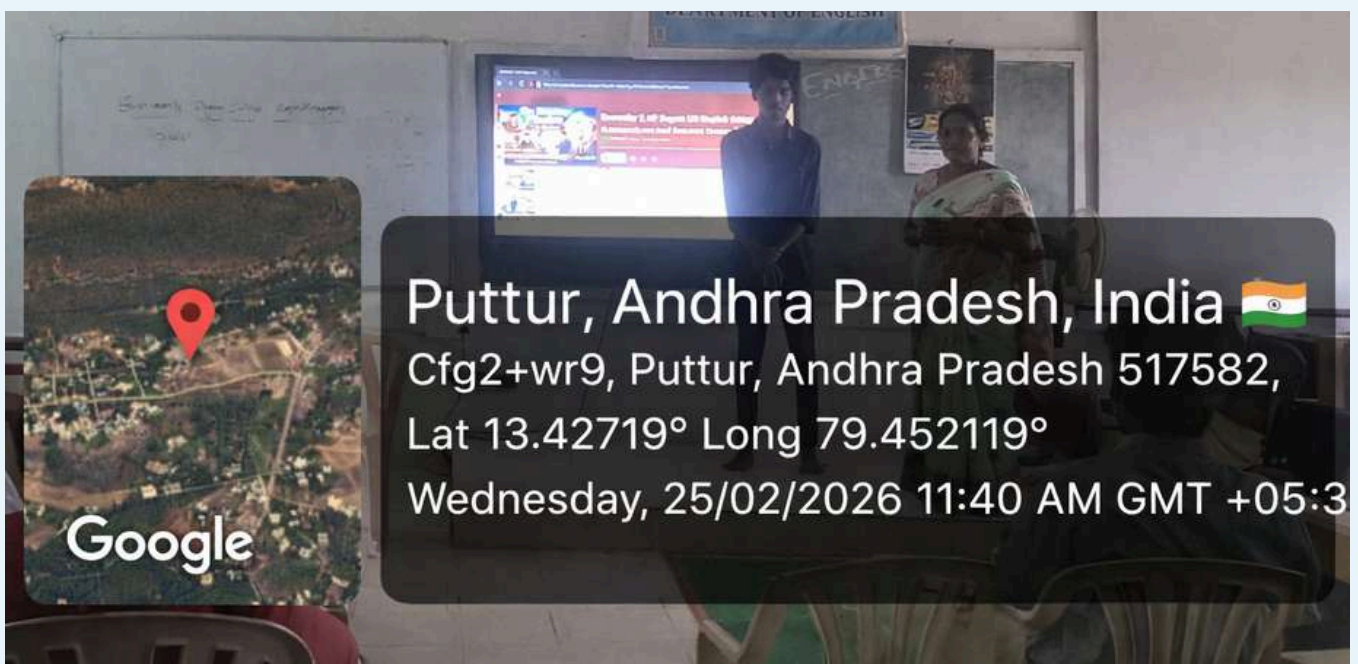


## DISCUSSION ON "BEING POLITE" - DEPT OF ENGLISH
