

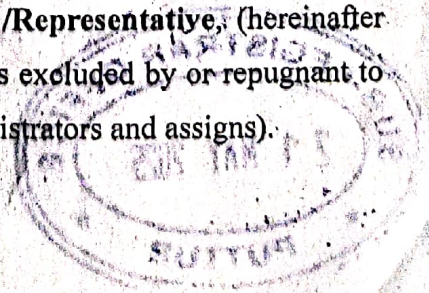

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- A) The Parties both are Higher Educational Institutions & Government Industrial Training Institute named
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D) Both Parties, desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Introduction

1.1. This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and entered into by and between the Government Industrial Training Institute (ITI), Karvetinagaram and the Government Degree College (B.A), Karvetinagaram, with the objective of promoting academic cooperation, skill development, and mutual growth for students and faculty of both institutions.

Objectives – Goals and benefits for students and faculty.

1.2. The main objectives of this MoU are:

- To enhance students' practical and academic skills.
- To facilitate exchange of knowledge and expertise among faculty members.
- To organize joint workshops, seminars, and training programmes.
- To strengthen local-level skill development and employability.

CO-OPERATION

1.3. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish of communication and respective operations within the Institutions and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another

1.4 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of both parties providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the students by acting as ambassadors to promote the institutions.

SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.1. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of the institution. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.2. **Curriculum Design:** Both Parties will give valuable inputs mutually in teaching /training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the present day needs meaningfully. Joint workshops to integrate *technical* skills (from ITI) with *soft skills*, communication, and social awareness (from Arts Dept.). Develop short-term certificate / add-on courses such as:

- “Communication Skills for Technical Students”
- “Entrepreneurship and Digital Literacy”
- “Civic Awareness and Work Ethics”

2.3. Responsibilities ITI, Karvetinagaram:

- Provide access to workshops and laboratory facilities for practical training.
- Offer technical guidance and industrial exposure to students.

2.4. Government Degree College, Karvetinagaram:

- Conduct sessions on communication skills, leadership, and personality development.
- Facilitate career guidance and placement activities

2.5. **Field Visits and Certificate /Diploma Courses:** This MOU will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the Student Community. The both Parties will mutually provide infrastructure/Labs/intellectual personalities whenever they are necessary for the students to conduct area study programmers/Field Visits and Certificate/Diploma Courses in their respective specializations

2.6. Research and Development: Institutions can enable to carry out the research activity based on the feasibility towards the development of both the parties on the interest of the students for the betterment.

2.7. Guest Lectures/Seminars/Conferences: Both Parties to extend their necessary support to deliver Guest lectures, Seminars and Conferences (Institutional/District/State/National Level) to the students of the institutions on the present day skills, technology, trends and employment opportunities.

2.8. Faculty Development Programs: Both the Parties to train the faculty for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available

2.9. Both parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the programmers on the terms specified herein.

2.10. There is no financial commitment on the part of the both Parties. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately. The MOU is initially for a period of 5 years and will be extended for another period of 5 years based on mutual understanding and in any event if the both parties disagree to extend / terminate the MOU, it will be with mutual consent without any legal issues.


INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY


VALIDITY


4.1. This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms.


4.2. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

- Office management and communication skills

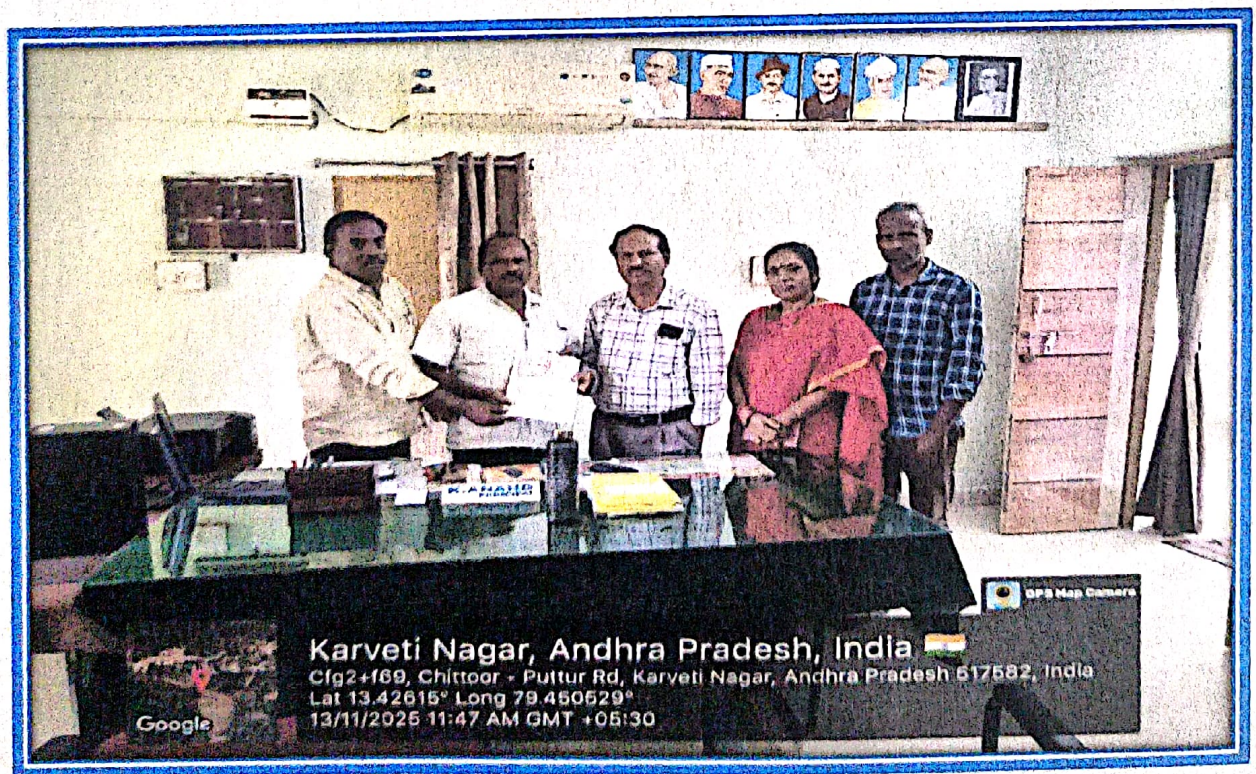
Expected Outcomes
